Dear Editor,

I write on behalf of 100 British, Commonwealth and Dutch business leaders in The Netherlands working to secure jobs and tax revenues for Maidenhead and the UK. The Netherlands is the UK's third largest trading partner.

As an example, I have spent over 25 years abroad, promoting Great British trade and foreign direct investment. I am British and a UK taxpayer, but despite that I am denied a vote. There are roughly 2 million UK citizens overseas in this category. You must forgive us for not agreeing that 'the UK voted for Brexit'. It did not. Less than 33% of UK citizens voted for it, and it was advisory not mandatory.

Theresa May spent 6 of the past 7 years as Home Secretary. During this time she lost control of immigration, the Border Force and the Prison Service, fired 20,000 police and 35,000 police support staff, presided over the worst crime detection rates in history despite locking up more of the population than ever before, and incidentally lost the debate to remain in the EU. As an unelected Prime Minister she has presided over growing chaos in the Health, Social Care and Education Services, riots in prisons, rises in violent crime, the worst terrorist attack in recent times, a further decimation of our defence forces, and the lowest rates of house ownership and highest rates of homelessness since the 19th century. She is incompetent and expensive.

Theresa May divides our citizens into factions and encourages us to fight in order to distract attention from her incompetence. She follows a path leading to massive financial loss for the country, risking mass unemployment and the break-up of the United Kingdom and leaving an impoverished England standing alone. As Maidenhead voters, you cannot disclaim responsibility for her when our country, our businesses and our families are betrayed. The crisis of the Brexit vote is past, but there is time to avert catastrophe...
